Friend of Public Schools Award

- Must be nominated by a school board within the Central Region
- 3-5 awards will be given
- Limited to community members or school board members (nominee may ***NOT*** be employed by the district submitting the name nor be a member of the board submitting the nomination).
- Each school district within the Central Region may nominate one person each year.
- Nominee must reside within the Central Region
- Nominee must have demonstrated value to education.

Exemplary School Employee

- Must be nominated by a school board of a district within the Central Region.
- 3-5 awards will be given
- Each school district within the Central Region may nominate one person each year.
- Nominee must be employed by a school district within the Central Region
- Nominee should be someone deemed critical to the success of a school district
- Teachers are excluded because they are recognized in the spring.

Nominations and supporting information must be received by July 1, 2009 to be considered. To nominate an individual, simply complete the form below and the explanation on the back. Because each district is limited to one nomination for each award, a majority of the board members must sign the nomination.
